

AMIK COTTAGE

on White Lake, Ontario



DRIVING DIRECTIONS

1. **From Montréal and Ottawa:** Take 417 West (Queensway West) to the Carp HWY 49 exit (exit 155) and turn left on HWY 49. This exit is about 15 km West of Kanata.
2. Stay on HWY 49 until you drive through Almonte (over two bridges) and reach HWY 15 (there is an Eso gas station on the right).
3. Continue STRAIGHT AHEAD across HWY 15 (HWY 49 becomes HWY 16) through **Middleville** and then to **Hopetown**.
4. At **Hopetown**, you are at the junction with HWY 511....take a RIGHT.
5. Drive down HWY 511 for about 24 km until you reach the turnoff (a right) onto White Lake Road.

N.B.: You are near White Lake Road when you see a sign for a boat ramp (on the right). White Lake road is the first right past the **boat ramp sign**. If you see the 'Welcome to Renfrew County' Sign on Rt 511, you have just missed your turn.

6. Follow White Lake Road (a gravel road) for about 1.5 km until you reach an intersection.
7. Bear LEFT at this intersection (there is a Gregoire sign on the right).
8. After about 1 km, there is another intersection.
9. Bear LEFT here at the sign indicating "NO EXIT, 6 km" (there is a Gregoire sign on a post)
10. AMIK cottage is nearly at the end of the these six Km. The 911 (small blue sign) outside of the driveway is # **1061**.

It will take you about 15 to 20 minutes to reach the cottage once you are on the White Lake Road. The Gregoire's phone number at the cottage is 613-623-6823.

From Perth and Smith's Falls:

1. Take HWY 43 to Perth (22 kms).
2. From **Perth** take HWY 511 towards Calabogie.
3. Once you reach Hopetown (about 40 kms) follow instructions above from #5.

The ride on HWY 511 is delightful....you go through some small villages such as Balderson (check out the cheese factory on the right had side of the raod....and Village Treats Chocolates for some good stuff). Carry on through Clydesville and on to Hopetown. Continue as per #5 above.
